Using Interfolio for Job Applications

The History Department will provide reimbursement for the annual fee incurred by those who wish to utilize Interfolio for their Dossier service(s). To be eligible for fee reimbursement, you must be a PhD track student who is **ABD** and currently enrolled in at least one (1) credit of study (HIST 699). Students can request reimbursement up to two times. (This year's fee is \$59.99.)

<u>Interfolio</u> is a fee-for-service online platform that provides secure storage of confidential documents such as transcripts, letters of recommendation, personal statements, letters of application, and writing samples to help students who are on the job market secure fellowships, post-docs, professorships, and various careers outside of academia.

The main benefit of the Dossier service is that it makes it possible to manage various documents and confidential letters of recommendation for multiple applications, enabling a scholar to apply to a large number of opportunities, and to apply on short notice if needed.
