Safe decorat ing guidelines

- x Never use decorations that are flammable.Exit doors are those doors you must pass through to leave the building or pass from one building into another.
- x Never hang decorations from ceilingsDecorations hanging from ceilings could allow burning particles to drop in a fire.

- In Residential Halls DO NOT decorate anywhere in thein corridors. Keep postingstice boards only.
- x Never use candles except as outlined in candle section of this document.

<u>Candles</u>

Candles are NOT allowed except for:

- x DiningHalls– Flames must be protected and the carsdle securely supported on noncombustible bases. Candles in globes rather than candelabras are required. Candles shall never be placed in the path of egress and never left unattended while lit.
- x Performing Arts-Where candles, sminlg, and other open flames are needed for a stage performanchetstage managemust contact EH&S and completetheatrical flame fects permit. Candles shall never be left unattended while lit.
- x ReligiousObservances– Contacthe RA or RDand use onlyri the area designateith the residential buildings. For other buildings, contact EH&S Never lease candles unattended while lit.

Reminder: Candles are not permitted anywhere on campus for casual use or aesthetics.
