When you make changes to your SUNY Voluntary 403(b) Savings Plan deduction amount in the Retirem who system (www.retirementatwork.org/suny), you'll need to choose an Effective Date, which can either be your "First Available Paycheck" or a specific "Future Date" set by you—as illustrated in the image below. Note: This is not applicable to the NYS Deferred Compensation Plan (NYSDCP) 457(b) contributions.



- Monitor your pay stub contributions. For year-to-date contributions, calculate the desired contribution amount based on the remaining paychecks in the year.
- Monitor your payroll information to ensure your contribution has been processed.
- If you are selecting a future effective date, please consider that changes may take up to 30 days to be effective in your paycheck.
- If you elect to contribute a flat dollar amount that exceeds the amount available in your net pay, a partial deduction will be made equal to the amount of net pay available. This will result in a \$0 net paycheck.

The SUNY Voluntary 403(b) Savings Plan permits both Traditional (pre-tax) and/or Roth (after-tax) contributions. The total (pre-tax and post-tax, combined) annual contributions combined cannot exceed the 2024 Maximum Contribution Limit.

Individuals under age 50: \$23,000 Individuals turning 50 or older: \$30,500
