Binghamton University operates on a year-round schedule that includes a fall and spring semester, as well as winter and summer sessions.

Binghamton has five undergraduate schools: Harpur College of Arts and Sciences (the liberal arts component); the School of Management, the Decker School of Nursing, the Thomas J. Watson School of Engineering, Applied Science and Technology; and the College of Community and Public Affairs. The descriptions that follow explain the transcripts for each of these undergraduate schools and the information noted thereon.

The Graduate School at Binghamton University also offers programs in the Arts and Sciences, Management, Nursing, Education, Public and Community Affairs, and Engineering, Applied Science and Technology. Graduate work appears on a separate transcript.

Grades for transfer coursework will be reflected on the transcript with the letter Binghamton University does not post grades received at other institutions. Transfer coursework will not be included in GPA calculations.
